

CRITERIA FOR TRANSFER CREDIT

★ Current Students only enrolled in the fall of 2016 at Great Plains Technology Center (GPTC) will receive college credit.

For future students seeking enrollment for 2017, Great Plains Technology Center, Radiologic Technology Program does NOT have an official contract or agreement with a college or university for you to receive college credit for courses taught at GPTC.

You may enter at your own risk, you will not receive any college credit towards completion of an Associate Degree. Without a degree in any field of study, you will NOT be able to sit for the ARRT National Certification in Radiography.

A Contractual Arrangement between Western Oklahoma State College and Great Plains Technology Center will allow **current students only enrolled in the fall of 2016 at GPTC**, to enroll in approved vocational programs and receive college credit leading towards an Associate in Applied Sciences Degree in Radiologic Technology. A maximum of 34 credit hours are awarded as a part of this Contractual Arrangement and/or prior learning assessment will be counted towards the Associate Degree. *An additional 7 hours are given as advanced standing in prior learning assessment upon application for graduation from WOSC for a total of 41 college credit hours. (*College Credits are subject to change due to the Oklahoma Board of Regents for Higher Education and the Higher Learning Commission.*)

NOTE: *There will be an \$8 per credit hour administrative fee to WOSC to enroll for college credit for Radiology Technical Occupational Specialty Courses during the fall and spring semesters of the program for the 34 college credit hours. The additional 7 hours will be paid upon application for graduation, for a total of 41 college credits to equal \$348.00 (41 x \$8). **College Credit are subject to change.*

GPTC IS A CLOCK HOUR INSTITUTION

- *The program contains 2533 clock hours of seat time or in session class / clinical time with a 1 to 1 ratio.*
- *Courses or combined courses will equate to 34 credit hours and 7 credit hours of prior learning assessment credit, upon WOSC application for graduation, awarded through Western Oklahoma State College, in Altus, OK as outlined above.*
- *WOSC Admission / Registrar office makes the initial determination of course transferability based on the transferring institution accreditation and the comparability of course work for the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Radiologic Technology. Course equivalents are subject to change without advance notice.*
